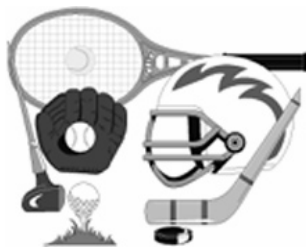

TAX EXEMPTIONS: In order to qualify for tax exemption, your billing must be handled in one of the following manners:
* Check made payable to the Columbus Marriott Northwest from the tax exempt organization.
* Organizational credit card. Credit card billing address must be that of the school district.

In addition, both sides of Ohio's blanket certificate of exemption and Dublin's certificate of exemption hotel/motel excise tax forms must be completed. A city tax (4%) exemption, hotel tax (6%) exemption, and state tax (6.75%) exemption—each requires a separate number. Please see your school treasurer for additional information. Note that unless all the above requirements are met, you are not eligible for tax exemption.

DIRECTIONS TO THE MARRIOTT NORTHWEST:

From downtown Columbus: I-70 west from downtown. I-270 north for about 5 miles. Exit Tuttle Crossing Blvd. (Exit 15). Turn right onto Tuttle Crossing. Turn left at Blazer Parkway. Hotel on left.

From Cincinnati: I-71 north to Columbus. I-270 west for about 15 miles. Exit Tuttle Crossing Blvd. (Exit 15). Turn right onto Tuttle Crossing. Turn left at Blazer Parkway. Hotel on left.

From Cleveland: I-71 south to Columbus. I-270 west for about 13 miles. Exit Tuttle Crossing Blvd. (Exit 15). Turn left onto Tuttle Crossing. Turn left at Blazer Parkway. Hotel on left.

From Dayton: I-70 east to Columbus. I-270 north about 5 miles. Exit Tuttle Crossing Blvd. (Exit 15). Turn right onto Tuttle Crossing. Turn left at Blazer Parkway. Hotel on left.

From Points East: I-70 west through downtown Columbus to I-270. I-270 north for about 5 miles. Exit Tuttle Crossing Blvd. (Exit 15). Turn right onto Tuttle Crossing. Turn left at Blazer Parkway. Hotel on left.

From Toledo: Rt. 23 south to Columbus. I-270 west for about 13 miles. Exit Tuttle Crossing Blvd. (Exit 15). Turn left onto Tuttle Crossing. Turn left at Blazer Parkway. Hotel on left.
